What is it? CROP Hunger Walk is a family-friendly 3.7-mile *or* .8 mile stroll through Carrboro and Chapel Hill, including UNC-Chapel Hill. Rest stops along the way provide food, water, and music.

Who benefits? Church World Service distributes 75 percent of funds raised to hunger relief programs in more than 80 countries. The remaining 25 percent benefits IFC's members and residents through the Food Pantry and Community Kitchen.

Who walks? People like you as individuals or as part of groups organized by religious communities, businesses, schools, non-profit agencies, or civic associations. Anybody is welcome who wants to contribute their time and/or money to support those in need.
